From the Pastor's Desk

The **Scriptures** are a **living word**. It is not about way back when only but about now, about you and I. The promise found in the words of this weekend's first reading from the *Book of the Prophet Zechariah* apply to us as the Lord promises to pour out "a spirit of grace and petition." As Saint Paul writes to the people of Galatia, he writes also to us: "*For all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ*" (*Galatians 3:27*). The question Jesus asks his disciples, He also asks of us: "**But who do you say that I am**" (*Luke 9:20*). Our understanding of the *living word* is reflected in how we live our life in Christ, how we understand what following Christ truly is. It is not about daily crosses only but shouldering our cross daily with Christ who is **the Way, the Truth and the Life**.

On this **12th Sunday in Ordinary Time** we also remember those we call *father* and pray that God bless them and they find in St. Joseph a special example and patron. To all the Fathers of our parish: "**A Blessed Father's Day!**"

Today, on this Father's Day, we pray that all fathers, stepfathers and grandfathers may be instruments of God's love and discipline, but never violent nor coercive in their behavior. We pray to the Lord.

Family Perspective
