On this *Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time* we hear about a **prayer request** that was granted. It was Solomon's asking God for "**an understanding heart**" (cf. 1Kings 3:5, 7-12). 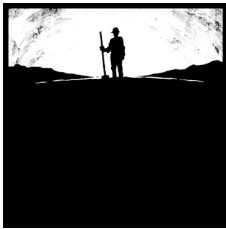
General Intercession
