Needed: Literacy Tutors to Help Break the Cycle of Poverty

Poverty is linked to illiteracy, and you can help break that link.

Volunteer as a tutor for **Seeds of Literacy**, a nonprofit organization providing free, one-to-one-tutoring in basic education and GED preparation to adults in Cuyahoga County.

Last year, a roster of nearly 200 volunteers assisted **1,000 students**. Tutors work individually with students on reading, writing and math skills, offer encouragement and support, and help students develop confidence and positive attitudes about learning.

All tutors are required to attend one tutor training session; no teaching experience is necessary. More than half of the Seeds of Literacy tutors have been volunteering for more than 5 years.

Once training is complete, tutors make a time commitment of one tutoring session per week for one year. Each tutoring session lasts 2 hours, and may be scheduled during the day or evening, depending on personal preference.
