Bishop Pevec was appointed Titular Bishop of Mercia and Auxiliary Bishop of Cleveland on April 13, 1982. He was consecrated a bishop on July 2, 1982. Bishop Pevec has served as a parish priest, pastor, seminary teacher, rector of Borromeo Seminary High School and College.
