### Fourth week of Lent – The Prodigal Son

The story of *the prodigal son* helps us refocus on the meaning of Lent. This is a time to change our ways, to turn back to God our Father, and to appreciate and share the gifts we have received. As we begin the second half of our journey with the Catholic Relief Services' Operation Rice Bowl, we remember that we are called to be stewards of what God has given us, and we connect our prayers and fasting with our giving.

### Needed: Literacy Tutors to Help Break the Cycle of Poverty

Poverty is linked to illiteracy, and you can help break that link.

Volunteer as a tutor for **Seeds of Literacy**, a nonprofit organization providing free, one-to-one-tutoring in basic education and GED preparation to adults in Cuyahoga County.

Last year, a roster of nearly 200 volunteers assisted **1,000 students**. Tutors work individually with students on reading, writing and math skills, offer encouragement and support, and help students develop confidence and positive attitudes about learning.

All tutors are required to attend one tutor training session; no teaching experience is necessary. More than half of the Seeds of Literacy tutors have been volunteering for more than 5 years.

Once training is complete, tutors make a time commitment of one tutoring session per week for one year. Each tutoring session lasts 2 hours, and can be scheduled during the day or evening, depending on personal preference.
