The U.S. bishops have called for a **Fortnight for Freedom**, a two-week period of prayer and action, to address many current challenges to religious liberty, including the August 1, 2013 deadline for religious organizations to comply with the HHS mandate, Supreme Court rulings that could attempt to redefine marriage in June, and religious liberty concerns in areas such as immigration and humanitarian services. On Thursday, July 4, there will be a 10:00am Mass at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist (1007 Superior Avenue East, Cleveland, Ohio 44114-2582) to conclude the 2013 Fortnight For Freedom.
