Today, people often try to get around the 5th Commandment with seemingly humane arguments. Euthanasia is not a humane solution. From the Vatican Instruction Donum Vitae (1987), "No one can under any circumstance claim for himself the right, directly or indirectly, to destroy an innocent human being."
