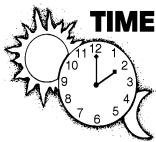

The Luminous Mysteries

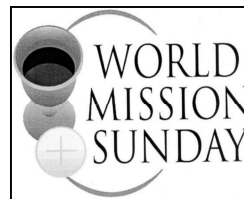
