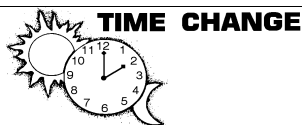

The recognition of the All Saints Feast day dates back to Pope Boniface in the 7th century when he dedicated the Pantheon in Rome to the Blessed Mother and the martyrs. Pope Gregory III made the Roman observance on November 1 when he dedicated a chapel in the Vatican Basilica to "All the Saints." All Saints day is a Holy day of obligation.
