- Faith requires free will and clear understanding of the divine invitation.
- Faith is absolutely certain, because Jesus guarantees it.
- Faith is incomplete unless it leads to active love.
- Faith grows when we listen carefully to God's word and enter a lively exchange with him in prayer.
- Faith gives us even now, a foretaste of the joy of heaven.
