Missionary Intention

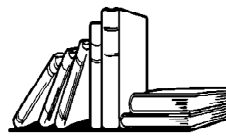

Sunday, February 3, 2013: Luke 4:21-30

Be my rock of refuge, a stronghold to give me safety, for you are my rock and my fortress. (Ps. 71)

- Is God your “rock and fortress,” or do you place your trust in things of the world?
- Reflect on a time when you gave or received “prophetic” advice. Were you or the other person open to the advice as a gift from God, or did you resist the message?
- How do you live the cardinal virtues in your life – faith, hope, and love?

Why do Catholics observe Lent?

Lent is the 40 day period of fasting and prayer which prepares us for the celebration of Easter. At the Council of Nicaea in 325 A.D., this period of 40 days of fasting and preparation was established. The number “40” may have its origins in the 40-day fast observed by Moses, Elijah, and Christ. Ash Wednesday was added to begin the fasting period in the 7th century so 40 days would be achieved, absent Sundays. In recent centuries meat was added except for Fridays. Vatican II shifted the emphasis from the physical suffering to other forms of penance including prayer and works of charity.
