

Regarding the Ordination Mass

On **Saturday, May 18**, the **Cleveland Rite Aid 5K Marathon** is taking place downtown Cleveland from **8:00am-10:00am**. The Marathon's route will impact those who are attending the **10:00am Ordination Mass at the Cathedral of Saint John the Evangelist**. The **Cleveland Police Department** has advised the following for accessing the Cathedral and surrounding parking:

For those arriving from the East: Exit from I-90 to Superior Ave. Head west on Superior Ave. and turn right onto E. 12th St. Then turn left onto Rockwell and continue to the Cathedral property or a nearby parking facility.

For those arriving from the West or South: Exit onto E. 9th St. and head north to the Cathedral. Traffic from the west and south may prefer to pass E. 9th St., remain on I-90 and then exit onto Superior Ave. heading west and turning right onto E. 12th St. Turn left onto Rockwell to access the Cathedral property or a nearby parking facility.

Exiting onto E. 9th St. from the westbound and eastbound Shoreway during these hours is not possible. It is recommended that everyone allow for an additional 30 minutes for travel.
