**Did Mary have other children besides Jesus?**

Jesus is the only son of Mary in the physical sense. Even in the early Church, Mary's perpetual virginity was assumed, which rules out the possibility of Jesus having brothers and sisters from the same mother. In the Aramaic Language, Jesus' mother tongue, there is only one word for sibling and cousins. When the Gospels speak about the "brothers and sisters" of Jesus, they are referring to his close relatives. (From the Youth Catechism of the Catholic Church) (Youcat #81)
