## From the Pastor's Desk



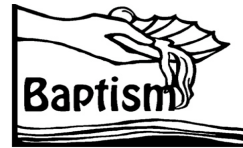

*"I have made you light to the

- After Paul and Barnabas were rejected by the Jews, they shook the dust from their feet and rejoiced in the Holy Spirit. Would you continue to have such confidence following persecution?

**What is the right way to honor  
the Lord present in the bread and wine?**

Because God is truly present in the consecrated species of bread and wine, we must preserve the sacred gifts with the greatest reverence. If there are consecrated hosts left over after the celebration of Holy Eucharist, they are kept in sacred vessels in the tabernacle. Since the Most Blessed Sacrament is present in them, the tabernacle is one of the most venerable places in every church. We genuflect before any tabernacle.
