He made his first vows as a Carmelite on June 3, 2002, solemn vows on August 8, 2006 and was ordained a priest May 5, 2008 at the National Shrine of Our Lady Mount Carmel in Middletown, New York. Father Joseph will be with us at all our Masses to tell us about the Carmelite missionary work. He will share with us how Carmelites respond to the call to love one another through prayer and action by establishing ministeries where there is the greatest need.
