LIFE CHAIN RETURNS TO AKRON

The Knights of the Father Maruskin Council of the Knights of Columbus invite you to join with them to pray in a powerful public witness of unity on the sanctity of life. Life Chain will be held on Saturday, October 4, from 11:00 until 12:30pm in a route extending from the abortion clinic on East Market Street to the Planned Parenthood Offices on West Exchange. We have responsibility for sections 4 and 5; on East Market across from City Hospital, from Spruce to Franklin Streets, a span of 650 feet. Ideally we hope to have 65 people in our two sections. The Knights and good people of St. Mary, Holy Family and Our Lady of Victory in Tallmadge will be joining us. Parking is available on the side streets, and, for a fee, at the hospital lot's. Carpools will leave the Holy Family front parking lot at 10:30am. Signs will be available. This area can be best accessed by exiting Route 8 south at either the Perkins or Buchtel Avenue exits.
