Family Perspectives

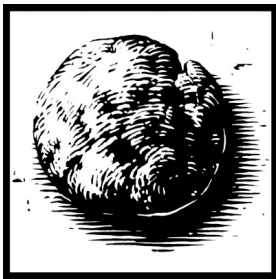
