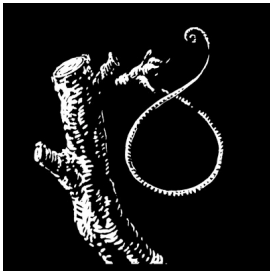
program focuses on the seven sacraments as primary means of spiritual development and how a person can grow as a friend of Jesus through them.

Nepal Relief Collection
