On this Feast of the Epiphany we celebrate that Christmas is without borders. Jesus our Savior is Christ and Lord for peoples of all times and places. Today we recall the coming of the Magi to do homage to the child Jesus. They presented gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. These gifts remind us that Jesus our Savior is Christ the King (gold), the priest (who will offer the sacrifice of Himself on the altar of the cross) and that His body will be placed in the tomb (the myrrh is spice used for burial). But Christ Jesus our Lord has risen victorious, the light who has overcome the darkness of sin and death and for us eternal redemption. Let us pray...
