(Note: Visiting 3 or more sites designates a fully stamped passport.)

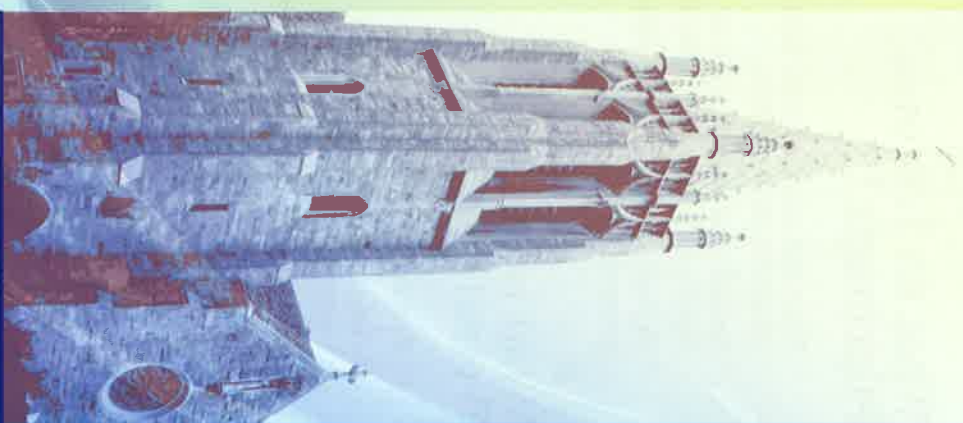
