As this letter is being written early on Monday morning, November 7, we are anticipating a very busy week. To begin with, the Saint Victor Parish Staff is conducting a site visit at Mother of Sorrows in order to assess issues relative to the physical plant. The diocesan facilities corporation visited the site on October 14, and we are looking forward to their report.

On Thursday morning, November 10, there will be a meeting of all persons responsible for the finances of both parishes:

We need to discuss several issues relative to establishing seamless, streamlined, transparent financial procedures for the parishes. While the funds of the parishes will remain entirely separate, there are some linkages relative to reimbursement for compensation as Mother of Sorrows will be responsible for a portion of my salary, bulletin preparation, and other services.

Also on Thursday we will conduct the Wine and Cheese Gathering for both parishes. While this is intended to be mainly a social event, there will be a sharing of some information relative to the transition. As of this writing, we are expecting about 70 people, equally split between both parishes.

Nancy Stokes reported to me that liturgy went well this past weekend at Mother of Sorrows. While there are some minor details that need to be fine-tuned, the procedure we have in place is working. Many thanks to Nancy for her hard work and dedication. Many thanks as well to all of the parishioners who served in various capacities last weekend.

I'm happy to report that we have some eighth graders from Mother of Sorrows enrolled in our Parish School of Religion who are preparing for Confirmation. I've also seen some Mother of Sorrows families at liturgy at Saint Victor. Please remember that Mother of Sorrows offertory envelopes deposited in the basket at Saint Victor will be credited to Mother of Sorrows, and this process will be carefully monitored by Lydia and Stanley.
