1. Food Pantry

Total number of people served was 798. Total number of households served was 276. Total number of children served was 274. Total number of seniors served was 94.

2. Clothing Bank

Total number of families served was 160. Articles of clothing given away: 1684 Winter coats given away: 90

Although we were only open three Saturdays because of Thanksgiving, the average number of families we had each week for food was higher than normal. Also, during the month of November we started to give away new blankets to each of our clients. These were bought with the money raised from the Blanket Sunday collection in October.
