**From India via Oklahoma to Peninsula, Ohio!**

***Welcome Father Prabhakar Kalivela (Fr. K)***

Mother of Sorrows parish welcomes this weekend *The Reverend Prabhakar Kalivela*. Father Kalivela is this year's Mission Co-Op Preacher for the Mission Co-Op Appeal and in particular for mission ministry in the Diocese of Nellore, India. Father Kalivela tells me that the people in the parish he serves at (Ephipany Parish, Oklahoma City) call him Fr. K. They do this because his first and last names may be challenging to pronounce. Father K was born into a Catholic family on July 1, 1969. He is the ninth child of ten. He has 6 sisters and 3 brothers. Fr. K was ordained on April 24, 1997 and is a priest of the Diocese of Nellore, India. Fr. K's bishop sent him to our country to serve in the Archdiocese of Oklahoma City in June 2017. Currently Fr. K is assigned as associate pastor at Epiphany Church, Oklahoma City. Father K has been to Akron in the summers of 2005 and 2006 visiting St. Sebastian Parish when Father William Karg was the pastor. This summer Fr. K discovers another part of Summit County and joins others from around the world coming to the Cuyahoga Valley National Park.



## From the Pastor's Desk

*Mission Co-Op Appeal Weekend*

*August 24 – 25, 2019*

*Diocese of Nellore, India*

The Catholic Diocese of Nellore is located in the south east of India along the sea coast of Bay of Bengal, in the state of Andhra Pradesh. It is constituted of two civil districts viz. Nellore and Prakasam. It has 35,000 square kilometers of geographical area. There is a total population of 6 million living in this area. Only 83,000 are Catholics. Diocese of Nellore is working among the poorest of the poor in the society. It interacts and renders its services without any cultural, linguistic and religious barriers. There are 173 ordained priests, 150 Religious, 400 catechists and 250 teachers rendering their services in the Diocese. Besides the evangelization and pastoral care in 400 villages with 80 parishes the Diocese of Nellore is carrying out a number of charitable and humanitarian services to the poorest of the poor, namely, the landless agricultural laborers (daily wage winners) and their children. We have 3 leprosy colonies, a home for children with physical challenges, a home for children who have hearing and speech impediments, and a home for children with mental disabilities reflect the service of the diocese in terms of the Gospels. Additionally, also there are 10 boarding homes / orphanages that are managed by the diocese as well. All of these and other spiritual and social needs are provided by the diocese, which in turn relies on contributions from outside sources. The Diocese of Nellore is a very poor mission and does not have any resources of its own to meet its basic pastoral and missionary needs. It depends on the ecclesial solidarity of Dioceses like yours. Funds raised from MCP are directly used for the pastoral care and evangelization only.

On this Twenty-First Sunday as we hear the Scriptures and listen about the Missions, let us pray...
