This weekend, May 30-31, Pentecost, we return to our Mass schedule of 5pm Saturday, 8:30am and 11am on Sunday. Remember the obligation to attend Mass is dispensed at this time. If coming to Mass be sure you take your temperature ahead of time, wear a mask and make use of the hand sanitizing station at the door of the church. Seating is limited because of social distancing.
