What is the Feast of "The Assumption" all about?

The Feast of the Assumption (August 15th) celebrates Mary's passage to heaven at the end of her life. This August feast dates to the 6th century when her dormition or "Falling asleep" became the focus of the feast day. The question of whether Mary was assumed "body and soul" was finally defined by the Church in 1950. The idea that Mary was assumed into heaven is connected to her having stood in the presence of God at the annunciation. (From the Modern Catholic Encyclopedia)
