Memorial Day Mass at MOS



Mass on Memorial Day, Monday, May 25 will be at Noon. Following the Mass (about 12:45pm) we will journey to our Parish Cemetery, Mater Dolorosa Cemetery, for prayers and blessings.

The cemetery is located east on Route 303 next to the Happy Days Visitor Center. (COVID – 19 protocols will be adhered to at Mass and at the cemetery).

Next weekend, May 30-31, Pentecost, we return to our Mass schedule of 5pm Saturday, 8:30am and 11am on Sunday. Please follow the protocols as requested in the letter mailed to parishioners, noted in the YCN, on our website and the diocesan web site. Remember the obligation to attend Mass is dispensed at this time. If coming to Mass be sure you take your temperature ahead of time, wear a mask and make use of the hand sanitizing station at the door of the church. Seating is limited because of social distancing. Let us all practice prudence, patience and charity as we move forward during this pandemic of COVID – 19.

Our diocese is live streaming a Mass daily at 9:30am on the diocesan website, and the weekend TV Mass is available on the diocesan website at 4 p.m. on Saturday. It can also be seen on Fox 8 WJW at 6 a.m. on Sunday. Those with Cox Cable can view the Mass at 11:30 a.m. Sunday on channel 45.
