General Intercession

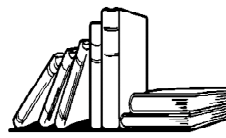
That captives of domestic violence may be set free from the cycle of violence by having the courage to call for help and by finding parishes that listen and answer their cry. Let us pray to the Lord.
