Who are we?

Catholic Charities, Diocese of Cleveland, is one of the largest, private, not-for-profit social service organizations in the country. For more than one hundred years, we have been assisting men, women and children in need throughout Ashland, Cuyahoga, Geauga, Lake, Lorain, Medina, Summit and Wayne Counties – without regard to religious or ethnic background.

What do we do?

Catholic Charities fulfills the Church's mission of charity by providing compassionate, competent, professional services that strengthen and support individuals, families and communities. We bring hope to the hopeless by providing food, clothing, shelter, counseling, and other services to those in need. Our clients can access a comprehensive network of services that range from food pantries to mental health counseling, emergency shelters, senior services, and everything in between. Our goal is to help each client become as self-sufficient as possible.

Where are we?

We operate 150 programs from more than 60 sites throughout the eight counties of Northeast Ohio. Community Service Centers located in each of the counties serve as the hub of our operations.

How do we do it?

For the past century, Catholic Charities has been blessed with the support of our parishes, the incredible generosity of the faithful, a strong commitment from our bishops and priests, the tireless dedication of our religious orders, strong lay leadership and volunteers, and a loyal and compassionate staff. We are careful stewards of the gifts that we are given: **86 cents of every dollar we raise goes directly to our programs.**

Some of the ways Catholic Charities Provides Help and Creates Hope:

- Making sure that people who are **hungry and homeless** receive food and shelter as well as job readiness programs and transitional services.
- Providing skilled care that focuses on the emotional, social and spiritual needs of people who are **elderly and chronically ill**.
- Helping **families in crisis** gain strength through counseling and providing emergency services, like food, clothing and baby formula.
- Assisting **persons with disabilities** by providing social and recreational activities, life skills training and in-home personal care.

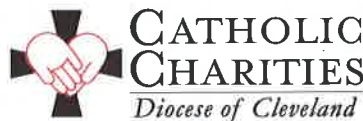
