Mission Co-op Appeal August 12-13, 2017

Next weekend, welcome The Reverend Fortunatus Mugisha of the Kabale Diocese as he presents the Mission Co-op Appeal for this year. Kabale Diocese is one of the 19 dioceses of Uganda, situated in the rural extreme southwestern corner of the country - about 280 miles from the capital city (Kampala). The Diocese borders Rwanda on the southwest and the Democratic Republic of Congo on the western side; and serves a population of 1,500,000 people, of whom approximately 700,000 are Roman Catholic.

This appeal seeks financial support toward the development of Rushoroza Health Center for the rural poor. Through the gracious generosity of many, the Kabale Diocese has managed to complete Phase I of the project (outpatient health unit). They are seeking assistance toward Phase II – construction of children's ward, labor and delivery unit, and emergency room. Healthcare is a most critical challenge as they continue to grapple with tropical life-threatening diseases such as malaria, typhoid, HIV/Aids, TB, among others. Long term, the health center will also provide most needed diagnostic services. Patients now have to travel all the way to the capital city of Kampala (280 miles) for disease diagnosis.

They are also seeking assistance for the Kabale Diocese Orphaned and Vulnerable Children Program. Through their foster home care program, out reach support is provided to orphaned children, the vast majority of whom have lost both parents, and are left all alone to fend for themselves. They currently support 386 children with school tuition, clothing and healthcare, and over 20,000 more children are in great need of help.

Pope Francis asks Youth

The Catholic bishops of the world are planning to meet in October 2018 for the 15th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops. The theme of this gathering is “Youth, Faith and Vocational Discernment.” In preparation for this major synod on youth, Pope Francis wants to gather input from the Catholic faithful. Consequently, the Diocese of Cleveland has made available a survey questionnaire to gather information on the current state of the young in our diocese that will be included as part of the pre-synod discernment document. The survey can be found on the diocesan website home page, www.dioceseofcleveland.org. All are invited and encouraged to participate by taking this short survey. The bishops of the United States pray that the results of this survey will help them more fully understand the experience of young people in our Church and in our country -- their hopes, dreams, fears and struggles -- so that the synod may bear fruit in offering more insight and direction to our ministry with young people.
