

Many thanks to everyone who participated in the annual grounds cleanup at Saint Victor this weekend. Many hands contributed to this project that was completed in just two hours. We had a parishioner show up in a front-end loader which dramatically reduced the workload for the volunteers. Thanks very much to everyone!

This coming week there will be a couple meetings at Mother of Sorrows to address some capital needs. Some landscaping plants need to be either trimmed or removed, more clearance for snow removal equipment needs to be created, and the driveway needs to be widened, resurfaced or replaced.

The security of the buildings in Peninsula has already been enhanced by the replacement and updating of locks; and now we are moving forward to install a security system including cameras. These are all elements of the transition process that is moving forward in a careful, intentional manner.

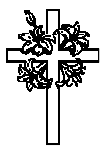
Many thanks to the visiting presiders who have been serving our parishes. Without the generosity of many senior priests, we would not be able to provide so many liturgical celebrations.

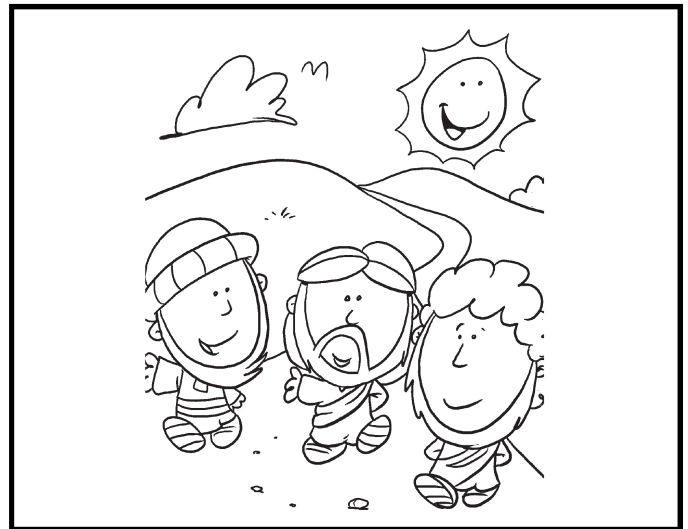
