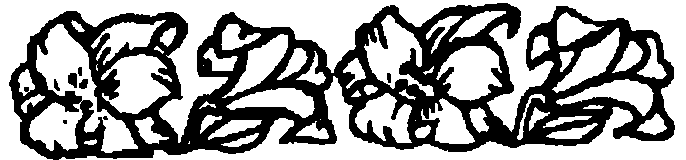


Saint Victor Parish Summer Mass Schedule

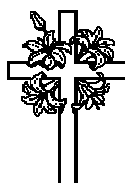
The Catholic Church in the United States is in the process of observing a time of "Eucharistic Revival." Our recent Church Tour program was related to that theme. Other events are scheduled as well, including a regional Eucharistic Liturgy with Procession on Sunday, June 4, in Cuyahoga Falls. Members of both parishes are welcome to participate.

The liturgy is being presented by Saint Joseph Parish in Cuyahoga Falls and will be celebrated by Bishop Michael Woost and held at the Cuyahoga Falls Amphitheater, 2050 Riverfront Parkway. After Mass, a Eucharistic Procession will head to Saint Joseph Parish Church for a benediction. A social with refreshments will be held from 1 to 2:30 PM for all attendees. We are slowly moving toward two celebrations that bring the Easter Season to a close: The Feast of the Ascension on May 21 and the Feast of Pentecost on May 28. For the Eucharistic Liturgies for Pentecost on May 27 and May 28 please get into the spirit of the feast by wearing something red. That is the liturgical color for the Holy Spirit.

The Finance Councils of both parishes had meetings recently. As the third quarter has been booked, we are getting a better idea of how the fiscal year will close. While it is too early to predict the final results, two things are clear. The Diocesan Investment Fund, which is utilized by both parishes, has seen a strong recovery in the past few months. Also, the big winner for us is Faith Direct, which also serves both parishes.

For any of our households who are not utilizing the Faith Direct eGiving platform, please consider it. Faith Direct has helped assure the financial stability of our parishes. It is also extremely secure by minimizing the handling of cash and checks. For Saint Victor through the first three quarters, about half of contributed dollars have come via Faith Direct which is found at <https://membership.faithdirect.net/OH1017>. For Mother of Sorrows there are two funds which are absolutely restricted to Mother of Sorrows.

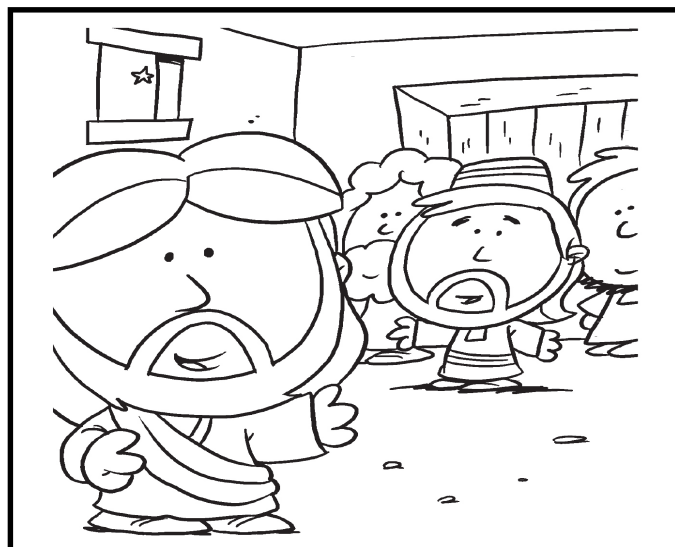
