

The next Saint Bernard Meal is going to be on Sunday, May 28. Our Saint Vincent de Paul chapter is hoping to recruit more volunteers for this important service opportunity. Kitchen Helpers are needed to arrive by 3:00 PM. Meal Servers are needed to arrive by 3:30. There are sign-up sheets in the Saint Victor's Gathering Room.

We are slowly moving toward two celebrations that bring the Easter Season to a close: The Feast of the Ascension on May 21 and the Feast of Pentecost on May 28. For the Eucharistic Liturgies for Pentecost on May 27 and May 28 please get into the spirit of the feast by wearing something red on May 27 and 28. That is the liturgical color for the Holy Spirit.

The Catholic Church in the United States is in the process of observing a time of "Eucharistic Revival." Our recent Church Tour program was related to that theme. Other events are scheduled as well, including a regional Eucharistic Liturgy with Procession on Sunday, June 4, in Cuyahoga Falls. Members of both parishes are welcome to participate.

The liturgy is being presented by Saint Joseph Parish in Cuyahoga Falls and will be celebrated by Bishop Michael Woost and held at the Cuyahoga Falls Amphitheater, 2050 Riverfront Parkway. After Mass, a Eucharistic Procession will head to Saint Joseph Parish Church for a benediction. A social with refreshments will be held from 1 to 2:30 PM for all attendees. It's good to note that the way this national program is being framed in the Diocese of Cleveland is as a "Parish Revival." This is very much in keeping with the important meditation offered by Pope Francis in his recent letter "Desiderio Desideravi" which is expressly addressed to all of the Catholic Faithful. Pope Francis' approach to Eucharistic Renewal is framed by Jesus' words, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer" (Luke 22:15). Pope Francis writes, "These words of Jesus, with which the account of the Last Supper opens, are the crevice through which we are given the surprising possibility of intuiting the depth of the love of the persons of the Most Holy Trinity for us."


