Dear People of God,

Saint Victor Music News: Knowing that our wonderful Parish Musician, Alena, will be pursuing her dreams at Ball State in Muncie in mid-August, we entered the recruitment phase for a Director of Liturgical Music. In order to lay down the foundation for our new Liturgical Music Program we needed to upgrade our aging primary musical instrument.

We received a notification of a piano and violin sale sponsored by the Cleveland State University School of Music in partnership with the Rockley Family Foundation. We intended to begin our search there. Much to our astonishment we found the exact instrument we were looking for at a phenomenal price. It is a 5'8" Yamaha Model G "Artist Grand," still in the box.

The cost of the piano was just below the \$25,000.00 threshold requiring diocesan permission. We hope to recoup the cost of the piano through direct contributions from those who are able to make an additional contribution for this purpose. If you are able, please consider being a part of the reboot of our Liturgical Music Program by making an additional sacrifice for Saint Victor Parish. Sacrifices made toward the purchase of the New Piano are absolutely NOT subject to the 16.5% diocesan assessment.

One way to help is to use *Faith Direct*, selecting "One Time Gift," placing "Piano" in the notes section, or a check to Saint Victor Parish with "Piano" on the memo line. Contributions can be placed in the basket, mailed or dropped off at the office. Thank you very much for your consideration!

Mother of Sorrows Music Info: I have had the opportunity to inspect and play both the organ and piano in the choir loft. Both appear to be in excellent condition and are quite serviceable without any repair needs at this time.

Both Parishes Invited: A regional Eucharistic Liturgy with Procession will be held on Sunday, June 4, in Cuyahoga Falls. The liturgy is being presented by Saint Joseph Parish in Cuyahoga Falls and will be celebrated by Bishop Michael Woost and held at the Cuyahoga Falls Amphitheater, 2050 Riverfront Parkway. After Mass, a Eucharistic Procession will head to Saint Joseph Parish Church for a benediction. A social with refreshments will be held from 1 to 2:30 PM for all attendees.
