Saint Victor Music News: Many thanks to everyone who has already contributed to the purchase of our new Yamaha Model “G” Artist Grand Piano. As of May 26, when this letter had to be submitted, we have already received contributions to cover half of the cost of the piano, which was just below the \$25,000.00 threshold requiring diocesan permission. We hope to recoup the entire cost of the piano through direct contributions from those who are able to make an additional contribution for this purpose.

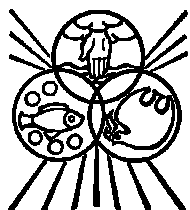

Mother of Sorrows Music and Other Info: I have had the opportunity to inspect and play both the organ and piano in the choir loft. Both appear to be in excellent condition and are quite serviceable without any repair needs at this time. In other news, the cellar door to the Parish Hall has been repaired, and it is much easier to operate.

Both Parishes Invited: The Catholic Church in the United States is promoting a time of “Eucharistic Revival.” Parishioners of Mother of Sorrows and Saint Victor who would like to participate in a Eucharistic Procession are invited to the regional celebration.

A regional Eucharistic Liturgy with Procession will be held on Sunday, June 4, in Cuyahoga Falls. The liturgy is being presented by Saint Joseph Parish in Cuyahoga Falls and will be celebrated by Bishop Michael Woost and held at the Cuyahoga Falls Amphitheater, 2050 Riverfront Parkway. After Mass, a Eucharistic Procession will head to Saint Joseph Parish Church for a benediction. A social with refreshments will be held from 1 to 2:30 PM for all attendees. 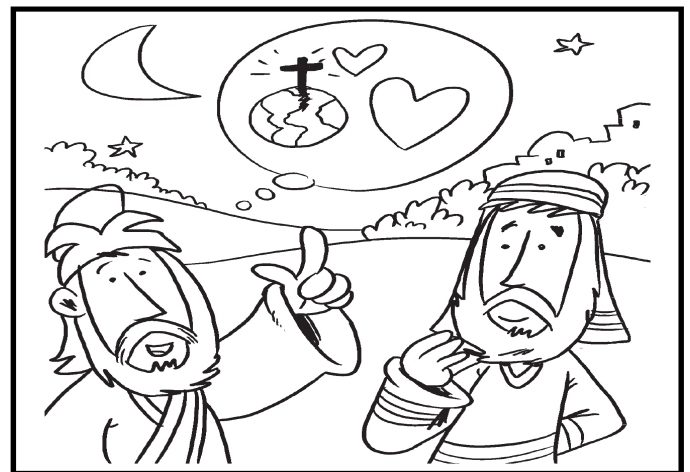
