## **Parish Faith Formation For All Ages**

**Bible Study.** Since our Bible study will be taking a break for the summer, here is part of a reflection provided by Greg Sunter and liturgyhelp.com. "The feast of the Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi, celebrates and commemorates the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper. Although the liturgy on Holy Thursday remembers the celebration of the Last Supper, its focus tends to be more aligned with the events of the Passion rather than on the institution of the Eucharist. In the 13<sup>th</sup> Century, Pope Urban IV established the feast of Corpus Christi (the Body of Christ) and it was St. Thomas Aquinas who composed the official prayers of the Church for the feast day. In 1970, the feast was changed to the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ."

Becoming Catholic – RCIA. The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process for any adult who wishes to become a full member of the Catholic Church. The process covers many different life situations. Perhaps you are a baptized Christian who is considering becoming Catholic and would like more information about Catholicism. Maybe you were baptized in the Catholic faith but never received the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation. Perhaps you have a child, 7-17 years of age who has not been baptized. If any of these describe yourself or someone you know, we are here to help you. Saint Victor Music News: As I am writing this letter on Tuesday morning, June 6, we have received about \$21,500.00 in direct contributions for the new piano. Wow! What an amazingly generous parish! Many thanks to everyone who has already contributed to the purchase of our new Yamaha Model "G" Artist Grand Piano, which was just below the \$25,000.00 threshold requiring diocesan permission. We do have an experienced Catholic Director of Liturgical Music lined up, and we plan to hit the ground running on September 1 with a rebooted program which will include choir for Christmas 2023 and Triduum 2024.

It's one of the four pillars of Catholic Moral Teaching that counters political excesses such as fascism, communism, forms of socialism and unfettered capitalism. The other three pillars are: The dignity of human life, the common good, and solidarity.
