
Parish Faith Formation For All Ages

Many thanks to everyone who has contributed to the Piano Fund at Saint Victor. I am delighted to announce that the cost of the piano is entirely covered by these special, direct contributions, with some additional funds remaining to cover the cost of a few tunings. You might have noticed that as the piano acclimates to its surroundings it is going out of tune. This was expected. Soon we will have the first tuning, and then the piano will sound better than ever.

In preparation for the reboot of the Saint Victor Liturgical Music program on September 1, the staff is beginning to clear out the previous "Pre-School Classroom" of the rectory ground floor. If you are familiar with the rectory, this room is adjacent to the PSR Supply Library and the Religious Education Office. The old Pre-School room will be converted into the Liturgical Music Office.
