Parish Faith Formation For All Ages

PSR/JYM Catechist needed for Grade 1. The commitment is to teach (almost) weekly, on Sunday mornings from 9:50 AM to 11:10 AM. We have ample resources available to help the catechist in lesson planning. They include a detailed teacher's manual, and handouts. Requirements include a basic knowledge and love of your Catholic faith and an initial conversation with the Director of Religious Education (DRE). There is also a child safety class called Virtus provided by the Diocese of Cleveland and a basic background check. If you feel that you cannot commit to every Sunday, enlist a friend to be a partner and apply as a team or perhaps you would like to be a substitute. Diocesan statutes require two full years of religious education prior to First Communion and Confirmation. There are forms at both parishes, and you can even sign up online. This week we send Saint Victor's amazing musician Alena Miskinis off to graduate school with our deep appreciation. Alena came to our assistance during a very challenging time. Many thanks to Alena not only for her musical skills and artistry, but also for her generous spirit. This is not really a "farewell weekend" because Alena's family and home are at Saint Victor and we hope to see and hear her frequently.

I am overjoyed to report that Saint Victor has recruited an outstanding Catholic minister of music beginning September 1. Herb Dillahunt will begin his tenure as Director of Liturgical Music on that day.

Herb Dillahunt, was born and raised in Springfield, Ohio, studied at Duquesne University in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, has done graduate work at Westminster Choir College, in Princeton, New Jersey, Duquesne in Pittsburgh, and the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. Herb comes to Saint Victor with many years of experience. He has ministered at Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Catholic Church in Midland, Pennsylvania, Good Shepherd Catholic Church in Braddock, Pennsylvania (the first consolidated parish in the diocese of Pittsburgh, six parishes into one, and then merged again twice), and for the past eight years at Saint Clarence in North Olmsted.

He has extensive experience as an organist, pianist, choral conductor, composer, arranger, handbell director and has been an officer in both the Pittsburgh and Cleveland chapters of the National Association of Pastoral Musicians (NPM), having chaired the national convention of the organization in 2012. He comes to Saint Victor with many ideas, hopes and dreams to build on the extensive foundation of the music program.
