Mother of Sorrows Feast Day. Join us in honoring the Patroness of our Mother of Sorrows Parish by recalling Our Lady's seven sorrows and praying the Novena to Our Lady of Sorrows (Mater Dolorosa) for seven days commencing September 9 and concluding on her feast day, September 15. This feast is celebrated worldwide. It recognizes the seven specific sorrows that pierced Mary's heart beginning with the prophecy of Simeon and culminating with her suffering alongside her Divine Son as he gave his life to save the world on Calvary. 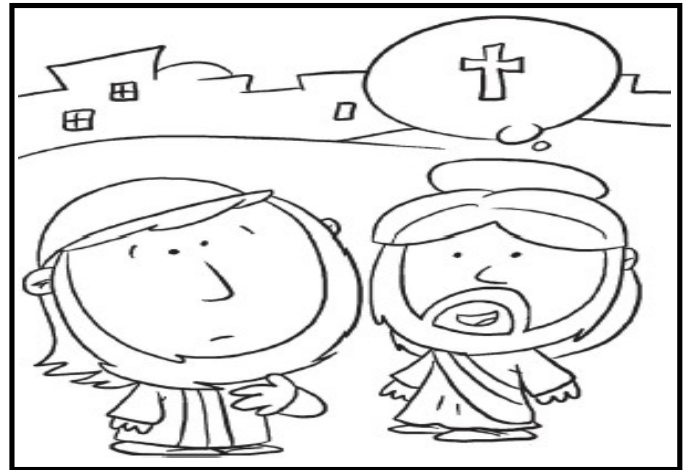
