

Join us in honoring the Patroness of our Mother of Sorrows Parish by recalling Our Lady's seven sorrows and praying the Novena to Our Lady of Sorrows (Mater Dolorosa) for seven days commencing September 9 and concluding on her feast day, September 15. This feast is celebrated worldwide. It recognizes the seven specific sorrows that pierced Mary's heart beginning with the prophecy of Simeon and culminating with her suffering alongside her Divine Son as he gave his life to save the world on Calvary. Dear People of God,

Saint Victor parishioners are asked to linger a while after liturgy this weekend for Pizza Saturday and Doughnut Sunday. We are having a reception for our new Director of Liturgical Music, Herb Dillahunt.

I was happy to see that Herb coincidentally selected for this weekend's Processional Hymn at Saint Victor "All are Welcome," which is a great favorite of mine. The image of Church provided in the text is powerful! "Let us build a house where love can dwell, and all can safely live." A line that keeps echoing for me is a reminder that Church is a place "Where all God's children dare to seek to dream God's dream anew."

This wonderful hymn has triggered a thought which I would invite members of both parishes to consider. Catholics often recall the October 11, 1966, words of Pope John XXIII when he opened the Second Vatican Council. He said it was time to "Throw open the windows of the church and let the fresh air of the spirit blow through." It was a marvelous metaphor.

Now, nearly 60 years later, Francis has pushed this image a step further. At the threshold of the Second Vatican Council, Good Pope John threw open the windows to let the fresh air stream in. Now at the threshold of the Great Synod on Synodality, Pope Francis has opened the doors so that everyone can come in. During his recent pastoral visit in Fatima he proclaimed: "The Church has no doors, so that everyone can enter." He continued, "A mother always has an open heart for all her children, everyone, everyone, everyone, without exclusion."

Many of us may have heard the saying, "When God closes a door, God opens a window." What we are witnessing at the turn of the Third Millenium of the Church is the opposite: The windows were thrown opened first by Pope John, and now the doors are kicked open by Pope Francis. And if that sounds strong it should, for not only does Pope Francis say that the doors are open, he suggested that the Church should have no doors at all! This is a great reflection for all parishioners of both parishes.

Meanwhile, in the interest of providing a spirit of welcome, please mark your calendars for Saturday, October 7, right after the 5:00 PM liturgy at Saint Victor. As always, this is also the day for our Fall Celebration of the Communal Anointing of the Sick. This event is for members of both parishes. It will be good for all of us to get together!




