Becoming Catholic – RCIA. The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA – formerly RCIA) is a process for any adult who wishes to become a full member of the Catholic Church. Maybe you were baptized in the Catholic faith but never received the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation. Perhaps you have a child, 7-17 years of age who has not been baptized. Dear People of God,

Saint Victor and Mother of Sorrows News: The Annual Barbeque will take place in two weeks on October 7. This is a great opportunity to get together for all of us! Tickets are being sold this weekend and next weekend after liturgies at Saint Victor and at the Saint Victor Office during the week, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 9 AM to 4 PM.

Annual Fall Mass with the Anointing of Sick: October 7 will be the annual fall Eucharistic Liturgy which will include the Communal Anointing of the Sick at 5 PM. We will have a couple of extra priests on hand to assist. Any baptized person aged seven and older who is aware of any physical, mental, spiritual or other special concern is welcome to receive the Anointing of the Sick. If a person has any doubt as to whether or not they should be anointed, it is best to err on the more permissible side and come forward for the anointing.

Most people will come forward for the Anointing of the Sick in procession. Since any kind of illness or challenge affects not only the individual but also members of their circle, those who come forward are invited to bring along a parent, loved one or caregiver to place their hand on the shoulder of the person being anointed as they are receiving the sacrament. Those who are not able to process forward can simply stay in their place and raise their hand, and I will go out into the assembly for the anointing.

It's not commonly known, but as one of the Sacraments of Healing, the Anointing of the Sick also includes the forgiveness of sin. That is why, consequently, those who are conscious of a very serious sin are encouraged to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance or to at least make a confession to a priest, prior to being anointed.

Annual Barbeque: The Parish Barbeque will take place right after the 5 PM mass in the Saint Victor Hall. Members of both parishes are welcome. This is not a fund raiser; tickets will be sold on an at-cost basis, and beverages available at a very low cost. The idea behind the Barbeque is to bring everyone together at the beginning of a program year.

The Annual Barbeque is a low-cost, enjoyable evening for all ages. I hope that everyone will make this a priority, because it is one of the best events of the year for our parishes.

Looking Ahead: The holy day of obligation Feast of All Saints is coming up on November 1. For the purpose of advance planning, Eucharistic Liturgies will be at Saint Victor on Tuesday Evening, October 31 at 5 PM and Wednesday Morning, November 1 at 7:30 AM. There will be a 7:00 PM mass on Wednesday, November 1 at Mother of Sorrows.
