Parish Faith Formation For All Ages

Becoming Catholic – RCIA. The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA – formerly RCIA) is a process for any adult who wishes to become a full member of the Catholic Church. The process covers many different life situations. Perhaps you are a baptized Christian who is considering becoming Catholic and would like more information about Catholicism. Maybe you were baptized in the Catholic faith but never received the sacraments of Eucharist and Confirmation. Perhaps you have a child, 7-17 years of age who has not been baptized. If any of these describe yourself or someone you know, we are here to help you. Sacramental Preparation. If you know of any families who have students in Grades 1 or 7, please remind them that the Diocese of Cleveland asks that there be a two-year preparation for the Sacraments of First Communion and/or Confirmation. While things were a bit different during the COVID season, at home and online classes were always available. Classes have been resumed the last year and this year. Students who were away for a while can enjoy classes this year with Mr. Rutherford and with Mr. Dutkiewicz the following year. They can register on the Saint Victor website.



October is Right to Life Month. This year Saint Vincent de Paul will donate a crib which will be set up in Saint Victor’s Gathering Room during the month of October. Let’s fill it with new and gently used maternity clothes, baby clothes and anything else that relates to babies. The donations will go to “I’m In Ministry” (<https://www.iminministry.com/>) which was founded eight years ago by Cleveland Diocese Deacon Lou Primozi to serve individuals who are most challenged economically and socially. Services provided include the delivery of furniture, food, clothing and advocacy. This center provides help to anyone in need of their services including babies and young mothers. Gift cards from local retailers are also appreciated. Place gift cards or monetary donations in an envelope marked for “October Crib Month” and put them in the collection basket. This is a great way to live our faith. Thank you.

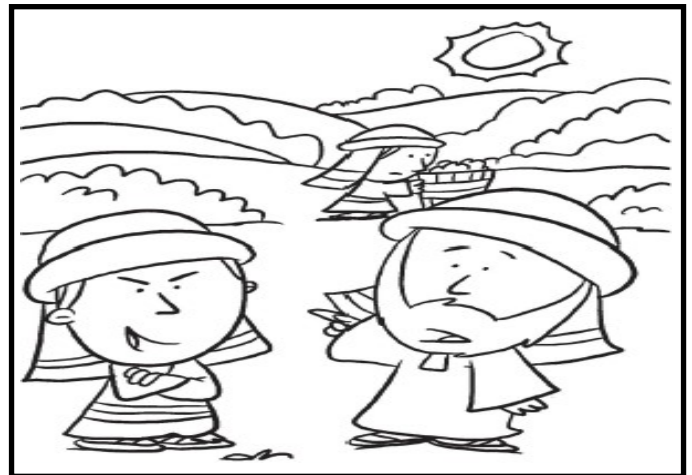
