Parish Faith Formation For All Ages

PSR/JYM. Next Sunday, November 5th, our students in Grades K through 6 will begin the Praesidium Program. This program gives our students the opportunity to learn how to protect themselves from child predators.

Also, on that date, a Confirmation Meeting for parents and students will be held in the Revere Middle School Cafeteria. This is the first step toward confirmation preparation. All of the classes are very important so attendance is crucial. We hope to see everyone there.



October is Right to Life Month. This year Saint Vincent de Paul will donate a crib which will be set up in Saint Victor's Gathering Room during the month of October. Let's fill it with new and gently used maternity clothes, baby clothes and anything else that relates to babies. The donations will go to "I'm In Ministry" (https://www.iminministry.com/) which was founded eight years ago by Cleveland Diocese Deacon Lou Primozic to serve individuals who are most challenged economically and socially. Services provided include the delivery of furniture, food, clothing and advocacy. This center provides help to anyone in need of their services including babies and young mothers. Gift cards from local retailers are also appreciated. Place gift cards or monetary donations in an envelope marked for "October Crib Month" and put them in the collection basket. This is a great way to live our faith. Thank you.

ACME Community Cash Back Program. The ACME Community Cash Back Program has started and will run until February 15, 2024. Please save your ACME receipts. You can either place your receipts in the "ACME Community Cash Back" box in Saint Victor's Gathering Room, mail or drop them off at Saint Victor's Parish Office. Thank you!

Dear People of God,

I heard back in May that the Diocese of Cleveland was considering Peninsula as a site for an important ministry of the diocese, which would have resulted in the refurbishment of the Mother of Sorrows properties. It was a long-shot, but it was an attractive opportunity. I was informed on September 25 that this plan had been taken off the table. Therefore, the temporary hold placed on addressing the needs of the MoS physical plant is lifted, and the most urgent needs can now be addressed.

On the front burner now is a deep, professional cleaning of the interior of the buildings in Peninsula. I developed a Request for Proposal and vetted it with employees and the Mother of Sorrows Finance Council. We'll begin to gather quotes and then move forward.

This is the kind of project that the "Building Fund" can be used for. Both parishes have such funds. The benefit of contributing to a "Building Fund" is that those monies can only be expended at the parish; and they are not assessed 16.5% by the diocese as are the regular collections. The best way to help is by using Faith Direct. There are two funds available for Mother of Sorrows via the Saint Victor Faith Direct portal, but these funds are strictly reserved for Mother of Sorrows. There is a "General Fund" tab, and a "Building Fund" tab.

I want to make something very clear. Mother of Sorrows is served by an outstanding employee, Molly, who does an excellent job as housekeeper with the ordinary cleaning duties. The commercial cleaning that is currently required encompasses deep, intensive cleaning that is well beyond the requirements of Molly's job description. Thank you, Molly, for your outstanding service to Mother of Sorrows!

Early this past spring I was informed that a group of Mother of Sorrows parishioners would be willing to pressure wash the vinyl siding of the rectory on a voluntary basis. This would be a good time to pursue this project, before the snow flies. Please let me know if this offer is still on the table.

Parish Financial Reports for both parishes are being published. They have already been distributed at Mother of Sorrows, and will be presented at Saint Victor in the near future. Expenses at Saint Victor remain low, and expenses at Mother of Sorrows are much lower. Nevertheless, everyone is reminded that all parishes are required to remain within budget in order to sustain themselves. Please study the respective reports with care. Many thanks to everyone whose meaningful sacrifices enable our parishes to remain fiscally sound.
