Special 12/24 Sunday Morning Schedule at Saint

Victor: Christmas Eve Day, December 24, is a Sunday, resulting in a modified schedule. At Saint Victor, on that Sunday morning, December 24, there will be only one mass at 10:00 AM. There are four masses for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day, 4 PM, 6 PM, 12 Midnight and 10 AM. As a result, attendance for Sunday morning, December 24 is anticipated to be light, so the two Sunday morning masses will be combined at 10 AM. We've done this the last two times Christmas fell on a Sunday, and it worked quite well. In fact, that last single Advent Mass at 10 AM Sunday morning had a very good "feel" to it.

Additional Mass at Mother of Sorrows: A mass has been added to the Christmas Schedule at Mother of Sorrows where there will be mass on Christmas Eve at 5 PM and Christmas Day at 9:30 AM. The entire schedule is published in this bulletin; please review it with care due to these updates.

Sacred Choral Prelude at Saint Victor: The Saint Victor Choir under the direction of Herb Dillahunt will be singing prior to the 4 PM Christmas Eve Mass, beginning at 3:30 PM. It would not be unreasonable to arrive by 3:15, or even 3:00 in order to be seated.

Giving Tree Thanks: The Giving Tree programs at each parish wrap up on Sunday, December 10. Please take care to bring your gifts by the end of Sunday mass at either church. Thanks to all for their acts of kindness during the Advent and Christmas Seasons!
