Dear People of God,

Thank You! Many thanks to all parishioners for their generosity to the parishes through the Christmas Collection and Building Fund contributions. Thanks also to everyone who participated in decorating the liturgical environments and properties for the holiday season. Once again, thank you to everyone who participated in the Giving Tree programs. Many families in our neighborhoods benefitted. Thank you for your generosity! Thanks also to all of our musicians and singers who enhanced the beauty of the liturgies.

Fiducia supplicans. Pope Francis has directed the Vatican Office for the Doctrine of the Faith to issue a clarification on the nature of blessings. There has been a lot of buzz about this 5,000 word document, so the best advice would be for interested parties to read it for themselves. Since there has been lots of mixed commentary about this declaration, some from disreputable pseudo-Catholic media sources, I wouldn't suggest googling the actual title. Here is a "Tiny Url" that will direct you to the text itself: https://tinyurl.com/5efjv7ck. Then scroll down to the English translation.

As Cardinal Victor Manual Fernández, Prefect of the Church's teaching office writes in the introduction, "The value of this document ... is that it offers a specific and innovative contribution to the pastoral meaning of blessings, permitting a broadening and enrichment of the classical understanding of blessings, which is closely linked to a liturgical perspective. Such theological reflection, based on the pastoral vision of Pope Francis, implies a real development from what has been said about blessings in the Magisterium and the official texts of the Church." (Emphasis added.)

Among other things, Pope Francis is making it clear that blessings of all couples, including those of the same sex, may be imparted. He makes it clear that we all need God's grace in order to become our best selves: "Indeed, the grace of God works in the lives of those who do not claim to be righteous but who acknowledge themselves humbly as sinners, like everyone else. This grace can orient everything according to the mysterious and unpredictable designs of God. Therefore, with its untiring wisdom and motherly care, the Church welcomes all who approach God with humble hearts, accompanying them with those spiritual aids that enable everyone to understand and realize God's will fully in their existence."

While there are some voices complaining that this document goes too far and other voices saying that it does not go far enough, it cannot be understated that acknowledging that every person, and every couple, has access to God's loving grace through presbyteral blessing is a wonderful prefigurement of the Kindom of God, where all are welcome and all belong.


