



# Imago Divina, Explained!

Imago divina (Latin for "divine image") is an extension of the ancient practice of lectio divina ("divine reading"). Imago divina is, in a sense, praying with one's eyes, or using the medium of artwork to assist in lifting the mind to God.

Believers have always connected with the divine through visual representations of faith. This can be seen in the frescoes that adorn the walls of the catacombs, in the glory of Rococo architecture, and in the stained glass windows of a simple country church. "Art is capable of making visible our need to go beyond what we see and it reveals our thirst for infinite beauty, for God," said Pope Benedict in 2011.



# FROM THE DEACON'S DESK



It is amazing how much has been accomplished in less than nine months. One year ago, the Renovation Program had not even been discussed. We owe a great debt to the Facilities and Finance Committees and to so many wonderful volunteers who have accomplished so much in this short period.

As I mentioned last week, because of your generosity we have collected 111% of our original goal.

We have completed 4 of our Top 10 Projects and we will complete 3 more by the end of the year. Our Facilities Committee is working diligently towards this goal. As you will see below, there is much more involved with many of the projects so I will share more details in upcoming bulletins.

As many of you know, about six weeks ago, the Church Hall flooded, and as a result, a significant portion of it will have to be gutted and replaced. While updating the Church Hall was on the Facilities Committee's horizon, it has now moved into the Top 10 List. We are working with the Diocese, the insurance office, the insurance adjuster and the restoration company to develop a plan for the renovation. Unfortunately, this is not a quick process.

## **Our Project Status:**

- 1. Replace Roof COMPLETED
- 2. Replace Gutters COMPLETED
- Install Windows in all Doors in Parish Life Center (PLC) - COMPLETED
- 4. Install Flooring in PLC- COMPLETED
- Replace Ramp on Front Porch- COMPLETED -Thanks to our Knight of Columbus.
- 6. Repair & Cement on Stairs- PARTIALLY COMPLETED
  - Rear Steps complete, Front Steps to be replaced.
- 7. Paint Exterior of Church- Have three quotes. Will be completed by this Fall.
- 8. Install Security System- Waiting for Homeland Security Grant
- Church Interior- Working with Diocesan Office of Worship
- 10. Replace Driveway- Quoted but waiting on sewer installation.
- 11. Repair Foundation- Soliciting quotes. Will be over \$25K and therefore will require Diocesan process and approval.
- 12. Connect to New Sewer when City Installs- Awaiting City Installation
- 13. Rehab Kitchen in PLC
- 14. Rehab Church Hall— Working with the Diocese, the insurance office, the insurance adjuster and the restoration company
